The full beam Master cabin on the lower deck has an en suite bathroom, a comfortable sofa & satellite TV & like all indoor spaces is fully air-conditioned.

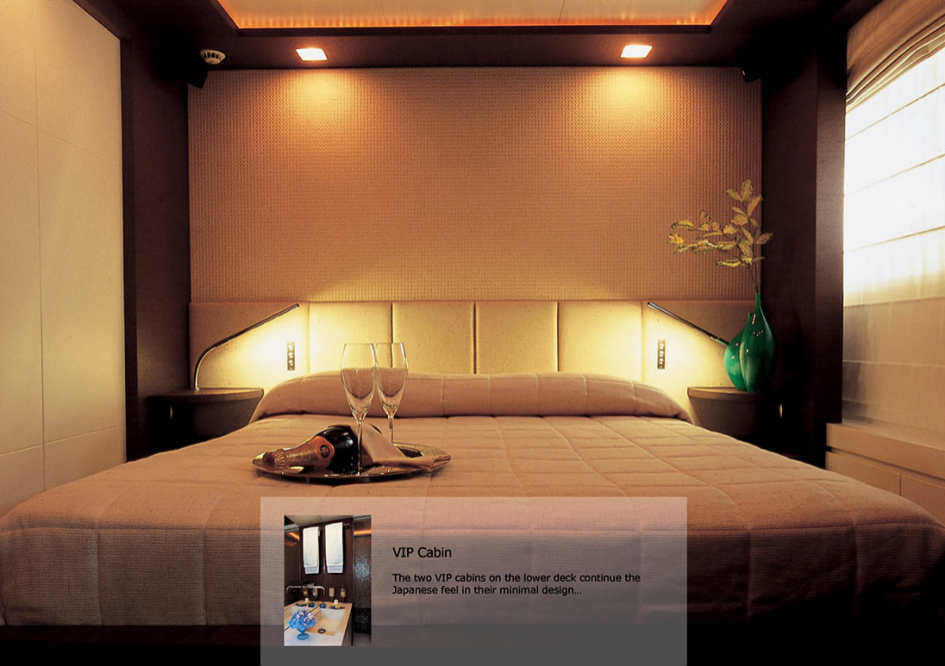
